: CLASSES

HD16, HD14, HD12, HD10

Ö1, Ö2, Ö4, Ö5, Ö7, Ö8

Cycle: helmet mandatory

Inlines: helmet mandatory, knee, wrist and elbow protection is recommended

Rullstol: same class with or without assistance.

GPS: competitors receive the controls coordinates, definitions and a map without printed course

Winners' time: 12–15 minutes

Punching system: Sportldent

Enter through Club-Online for participants in Swedish clubs. Foreign competitors can enter using the entry form which should be then sent to entry@sttunaik.nu

Entries must be received by the 15th May.

Entry fee: juniors 35 SEK, adults 80 SEK

Entry fees will be invoiced to Swedish clubs following the competition.

Late entries: will be charged a 50% surcharge on top of the entry fee until the 22nd May 2006.

Rental Sportldent pins are available for 20 SEK. Specify in your entry if you require one. Persons losing rented Sportldent pins will be charged 300 SEK

: THE MAP

Map scale 1:4 000 Contour interval 2 m

Terrain type: Park and town, approximately 65% grass, 29% asphalt, 5% gravel, 1% forest.

The competition area is open until 11:59 p.m. on the 24th May after which competitors may only enter the parts of the competition area specified in the map published in the program.

Printed copies of the competition map which will be presented on the Internet may be used for training within the competition area in accordance to the previous paragraph.

Metal dubbed and spiked shoes are strictly forbidden. There are no full-body clothing requirements.

There is traffic throughout the whole competition area and it is the competitor's responsibility to follow traffic rules. Mandatory crossing points marked on the map **MUST** be used.
